

## BULL RUN DISTILLERY

Lee Medoff began his career as a brewer, then moved on to winemaking where he first became exposed to distillation. He started House Spirits Distillery in 2004, and was one of the founding members and first president of the Oregon Distillers Guild, America's first craft distillers guild. In 2010, with his sights set on making a pure malt Oregon Whiskey, he started Bull Run Distillery. It is here that he focuses on creating dark, aged spirits, from rum made with Hawaiian cane sugar to many expressions of whiskey.



Bull Run Distilling Company's American Whiskey is the second great find in their Merchant Bottling Series. A fine contrast to the other barrel-heavy Bourbon expressions, this whiskey delivers solid flavors and a smoothness that results in a rare drinkability for a lighter-style whiskey.

**Base Ingredient/Mash:** 96% corn and 4% malted barley purchased from Great Western Malting

**Still Size & Type:** 700 gallon steel column still

**Distillation:** Double distilled

**Maturation:** Aged for nine years in used Bourbon barrels

**Filtration:** Chill-filtered

**Finishing:** Proofed with water from Bull Run Reservoir

**Alcohol:** 41%

**Country:** USA

**Region:** Oregon

**Sub Region:** Portland

**Spirit Style:** Whiskey

**Distiller:** Lee Medoff
