The Barrique Pinot Noir 2021 offers a rich and complex tasting profile that showcases the characteristics of this elegant varietal. A subtle hint of toasted bread adds an extra layer of complexity, likely resulting from oak aging. The palate of this Pinot Noir is equally impressive, with a finely textured mouthfeel characterized by dusty tannins. Its high acidity contributes to the wine's vibrancy and freshness, while its good strength suggests a medium to full-bodied wine. The flavor profile harmoniously balances deep earth notes with vibrant fruit characteristics, particularly raspberry.
