Named in the 18th century by Jean-Baptiste Coussin, Château Coussin was acquired by Baptistin Gautier in 1903 and is now managed by his descendants, Olivier and Sophie Sumeire, representing the eighth generation of Provençal winemakers. Domaine Coussin - La Croix du Prieur is crafted from vines classified as AOP Côtes de Provence at Château Coussin. The estate's emblematic carved pediment adorns the labels of its wines, reflecting its rich heritage. A pale pink hue with silver highlights reveals a delicate nose of wild strawberries and hints of lemon. The palate is full and well-balanced, featuring notes of pink grapefruit and orange, leading to a refined citrus zest finish. Perfect with sea bream ceviche, spicy world cuisine, and ideal for brunch or al fresco dining.
