ABOUT THIS BOTTLE

Located in the exceptional terroir of Sainte-Victoire Mountain, where vines have been cultivated since Antiquity, Château Coussin was acquired in 1903 by Baptistin Gautier and is now owned by his descendants, Olivier and Sophie Sumeire, eighthgeneration winemakers in Provence. This 150-hectare vineyard, half of which is classified as AOP Sainte-Victoire, produces high-quality rosé, red, and white wines of exceptional elegance. The estate's emblematic carved pediment adorns the labels of its wines, reflecting its rich heritage. A pale, elegant color with delicate pink highlights. The "classic Coussin" nose opens with aromas of strawberry, followed by pleasant notes of nectarine and apricot. This aromatic prelude unfolds into a floral palate of rosehip, vibrant and full-bodied, leading to a refined finish of orange and tangerine. A Sainte-Victoire rosé perfect for any season. This wine pairs beautifully with refined seafood dishes such as tuna tartare, gravlax, and lobster risotto, as well as a succulent rack of lamb.
