Total Production:	672cs
Vineyard:	part of a 20ha farm that is about 3km south of Malmesbury. Bush vines with large fluctuations in yield vine to vine. Entire farm has been farmed organically for 15 years
Soil:	ferricrete topsoil with granite beneath
Age of Vines:	1985
Climate:	hot and dry
Farming Methods:	hand harvested February 17th 2021
Fermentation Methods:	natural fermentation with indigenous yeasts in stainless steel tank and bottled before fermentation is complete, at .8 brix. Fermentation finishes in bottle leaving sediment
Winemaker:	Johan Meyer

All about this bottle

This pet nat is from a single vineyard of cinsault in Swartland. The vineyard is 37year old organic bush vines and the wine is made without any addition of sulfur in addition to being vegan, climate neutral, and certified B corp. Like all Lubanzi wines, 50% of the annual profits are shared with the growers via the Pebbles Project.

Cloudy deep pink with a good amount of fizz. On the nose, ripe strawberry and candy. On the palate, reminiscent of ruby red grapefruit, tart kombucha, and wild strawberries. Drink ice cold on a hot day.



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
