## All about this bottle

Luli is a partnership between Sara Floyd MS and the Pisoni family. The goal is to make quality, handcrafted wine at reasonable prices from well farmed vineyards. The fruit is purchased from vineyards in Santa Lucia Highlands and other coastal regions in California. The 2021 Pinot Noir is from a variety of sustainably farmed vineyards in the Santa Lucia Highlands. The grapes were hand-harvested and the must fermented with native yeast. The wine was aged in neutral French oak barrels before being bottled un-fined and unfiltered. Driven by fruit and spice, this bottling of Pinot Noir highlights what a cool climate and California sunshine can produce together.
