The 2021 Pinot Noir is from a variety of sustainably farmed vineyards in the Santa Lucia Highlands. The grapes were hand-harvested and the must fermented with native yeast. The wine was aged in neutral French oak barrels before being bottled un-fined and unfiltered.
