Crisp flavors of tart bing cherry, ripe raspberry, and blackberry bramble shine from first sip to last. Secondary notes of rose petal, fresh oregano, forest floor, and mocha reflect the terroir of the Mayacamas foothills in northern Los Carneros, with its rich red soil and organic, regenerative farming practices. Elegant, understated French oak frames the wine, complementing its savory core. This harmonious blend of Merlot, Cabernet Franc, and Cabernet Sauvignon promises to evolve beautifully with age.
