#### All about this bottle

Established in 1969, Titus Vineyards is a family owned vineyard and winery located at the base of Howell Mountain along the Silverado Trail in the heart of the St. Helena AVA. Over the past 50 years, some of the valleys finest wines including Charles Krug, Beaulieu Vineyards, and Cuvaison have originated from Titus' historic vineyards. Brothers Eric and Phillip Titus believe in a low-intensity approach is based on techniques that avoid pesticides, biocides, and unnecessary fertilization and encourages cover crops, beneficial native species, and soil health. They believe that high-quality fruit begins with carefully matching the proper rootstock and variety to the particular soil of each vineyard block. The 2022 Sauvignon Blanc comes from a well drained section of the estate vineyard. It was whole cluster pressed into stainless steel and fermented. The wine was aged for 4 months in neutral French oak barrels, adding complexity and texture to the wine, and an additional 4 months in stainless steel. Aromatic, zesty, and crisp, this bottling of Sauvignon Blanc reminds us that Napa Valley Sauvignon Blanc isn't a monolith.
